Pick-up

After school R.E.C. Crew concludes at 5:30 p.m.

Please make every effort to be on time to pick up your child.

Photo identification must be shown in order to pick up your child. Only those listed on your pick-up list will be able to pick up your child. If for some reason someone else must pick up your child, please send a note or call the office at (203)484-6017. Please let anyone else picking your child up know they must provide photo identification.

When picking-up, please do not park in the fire lane in front of the building.

Program Design

The after school R.E.C. Crew will be separated into 2 age-appropriate groups and will have the opportunity to engage in Art, crafts, sports, games and fitness. Homework help will also be offered in order to get a jumpstart on assignments.

Additionally, a snack time will be offered during the afternoon. Please pack your child a **peanut-free** snack!

Health & Safety

We understand that the after school R.E.C. Crew provides not only essential childcare services, but also plays a significant role in each child's development. Safety is our priority, and we will continue to follow best practices to keep everyone healthy.

At this time, masks must still be worn indoors. They can be removed when safely distanced and seated and while eating. We have increased sanitization of high touch surfaces and items and have implemented more frequent handwashing and will do our best to keep everyone safely distanced.

If your child requires medication while at the after school program, a medication authorization form must be filled out by the child's physician. All medication must be in the original container and labeled with the child's name. Medications, except for Epi-pens and inhalers, will be double locked in the Recreation Supervisor's office.

All staff are First Aid and CPR certified. Additionally, both the Recreation Supervisor and Director are Medication and Epi-pen certified.

By Connecticut state law, North Branford Parks & Recreation Staff are mandated reporters:

mandated reporters must make the report when, in the ordinary course of their employment or profession, they have reasonable cause to believe or suspect that a child under age 18 has been abused, neglected, or placed in imminent risk of serious harm (CGS § 17a101b). (cga.ct.gov)

What to pack every day for your child:

Mask

Water bottle clearly labeled with the child's name (please do not send glass)

Peanut-free snack

*Please note that North Branford Parks & Recreation is not responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged items brought to camp.

Behavior expectation:

We expect your child to arrive each day prepared to be courteous and respectful of others. If a child deliberately harms another individual, they will be suspended immediately. We will work hard at meeting the individual needs of your children and families, however if a child is written up for inappropriate behavior 3 times, they may not be able to continue to attend the program.
