Williams Community Center, their officers, employees and agents from and against any and all losses, claims, costs, damages, judgments, suits and expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees arising from, alleged to arise from, or resulting in personal injury to me, any third party, or my property and from and against any claims of injuries or damages that I may cause to any person or property. I do understand that if I am injured while participating in any program or activity, I am solely responsible for any and all costs that I may cause or incur, including medical treatment.

In addition, the undersigned understands and acknowledges that the novel coronavirus ("COVID-19") has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization and is extremely contagious. By signing this agreement, the undersigned acknowledges the contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assumes the risk that the undersigned may be exposed to and/or infected by COVID-19 at any point during the undersigned's utilization of STW Community Center services, programs and/or activities and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability and/or death.

Member Code of Conduct

- All Town of North Branford Facility Policies as set by the Town of North Branford or the East Shore District Health Department apply to all North Branford Parks, Recreation & Senior Center facilities and activities. Those who violate policies may not be permitted to participate.
- Please treat everyone with dignity and respect.
- The use of abusive, intimidating, threatening, or harassing language is strictly prohibited and will not be tolerated.
- Fighting, physical abuse, challenging others to fight, destroying or damaging property and other disruptive, intimidating, or harassing behaviors are strictly prohibited.
- Alcohol and drugs shall not be brought to and/or consumed at Town buildings, properties, vehicles, and events.
 Anyone under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be asked to leave. Law enforcement may be notified, as appropriate, when criminal activity is suspected.
- Weapons of any kind are not permitted.
- The Stanley T. Williams Community Center does not provide sleeping accommodations. Lying outstretched or sleeping on the furniture or the floorisnot allowed.
- Proper shoes and clothing must be worn at all times.
- No solicitation or sales of goods or services by an individual, participant or group are allowed.
- Please refrain from any PDA (public display of affection) which includes but is not limited to: sexually explicit dancing, kissing, groping and lap sitting.

General Facility Rules

- Participants must complete and submit a registration upon joining the Senior Center.
- Participants must scan card/sign-in at each visit.
- Participants are not allowed in staff areas (kitchen, offices, closets) without staff permission.
- Service Animals (as defined by federal and state law) may enter the Center, must be restrained, and under the supervision of their companion or owner at all times.
- Animals may not be left unattended outside.
- Community phone use is limited to local calls and emergencies.
- Restrooms shall not be used for bathing, shaving, or washing clothes.
- The Community Center is a smoke-free campus therefore smoking is strictly prohibited in the building or on the premises.
- Personal belongings must not be left unattended.
- Any minor visiting in Stanley T. Williams Community Center must be signed in and supervised by his/her guardian at all times. Minors who are volunteering must have parental approval and be under the supervision of designated staff, teacher or parent at all times.
- All senior center participants under 55 years of age who participate in the lunch program shall pay \$5.00 per meal and wait until eligible seniors have been served.
- Please be courteous and ask permission to use photographs, videos, etc.
