On the last day of AAC Awareness Month, Augmentative and Alternative Communication (AAC) Boards were successfully installed on

October 31 at both, North Farms Park and Northford Park in collaboration with Beyond the Horizon, Inc.

These large, durable boards feature symbol-based communication systems and have been placed near the playground areas to make communication more accessible for individuals who use AAC.

The boards allow individuals with communication challenges the opportunity to engage in meaningful play and interaction with their peers in

open community spaces, while fostering connection, confidence, and inclusion for children and families alike.
